Requirements for submission of abstract:

- Maximum 300 words (English)
- Font style: Times New Roman, Size 12, Single spacing
- Follow IMRaD format

Guidelines for the Online Paper presentation

Send a short video of the presentation with a clear visibility of the presenter's face

Time duration: Not more than 5 minutes with maximum 15 slides

Guidelines for the e-poster

- The title of the poster should be same as that of your approved abstract
- The size of the poster should be 18" x 24" (46 cms x 61 cms) in portrait view

- ✓ Abstracts of both paper and poster need to be submitted through e-mail on or before 25/01/2022
